How to always win at Rock-Paper-Scissors

(A) Rhythmical fast chanting

First, take control of the game by yelling loudly.

While waving your fist, chant rhythmically in three beats.



First! Comes! Rock! Rock! Paper! Scissors!

It creates the illusion of a certain rhythm, and then chants at a high speed at last.

First! Comes! Rock! Rock! **Paper-Scissors!** (fast chanting)



Plan A is rhythmical fast chanting.

First, take control of the game by yelling loudly.

While waving your fist, chant rhythmically in three beats.

First!, Comes!, Rock!, Rock!, Paper!, Scissors!

It creates the illusion of a certain rhythm, and then chants at a high speed at last.


First!, Comes!, Rock!, Rock!, Paper-Scissors!

At the time of "Paper!", everyone should still have the rock they started with.

At the time of "Paper-Scissors!", you win by putting up a paper hand.

How to always win at Rock-Paper-Scissors

(B) Submarine scissors



Instead of holding your hand horizontally, hold it out as low as possible.

Bend your wrist as far as you can to make scissors.

Keep your fingers slightly bent, without fully extending them.

Because your opponent can only see the back of your hand, they'll think it's rock.

Plan B is submarine scissors.

Instead of holding your hand horizontally, hold it out as low as possible.

Bend your wrist as far as you can to make scissors.

Keep your fingers slightly bent, without fully extending them.

Because your opponent can only see the back of your hand, they'll think it's rock.

If your opponent shows scissors, quickly declare victory.

If your opponent shows paper, insist, "Look closely, that's scissors".

How to always win at Rock-Paper-Scissors

(C) Serious rock-paper-scissors

Confirm beforehand,

"Is it okay if we just get one **serious rock-paper-scissors** match?"

Your opponent will think this is to confirm the number of tries.

When you say "Rock, paper, scissors!",

punch your opponent in the stomach with your fist.

Declare "One point! The match is over!"

Plan C is serious rock-paper-scissors.

Confirm beforehand, "Is it okay if we just get one serious rock-paper-scissors match, without any complaints?"

Your opponent will think this is to confirm the number of tries.

When you say "Rock, paper, scissors!", punch your opponent in the stomach with your fist.

Declare "One point! The match is over!"
